GP prioritisation and consolidation

Basis for Prioritisation

- SHGs should discuss and write the names of beneficiaries in the order of priority
- Vulnerable or the marginalised section of the community get preference on availing benefits.
 - Person with Disability
 - Elderly
 - Women headed households including single mother, unwed mother, abandoned, widow and separated etc.
 - Victims of witch hunting
 - Particularly Vulnerable Tribal Groups
 - Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe
 - Homeless and destitute
 - Bed ridden/ Paralysed
 - Persons belonging to Transgender communities
 - Bonded labourers, Migrant labourers
 - Persons with terminal or Incurable disease
 - Woman victims of atrocities/trafficking
 - Sanitation workers
 - Households with no source of income

Process of Entitlement Plan Preparation

SHG Level Demand Preparation:

Entitlement Demands of SHG members will be prepared on a prioritized basis in each SHG.

VO Level Summary Sheet/ Consolidation:

The SHG level demands have to be attached along with the VO summary sheet at VO level. Demands of vulnerable/PoP members outside SHG fold should be added at this level. This will be the VO level

Entitlement Plan

GP level Prioritization for:

- MGNREGS work demand
- 2. NSAP
- 3. PMAY –G

GP Level Summary Sheet / Consolidation:

If there are more than one VO in a GP, then the VO level Entitlement plans should be attached along with the GP summary sheet at GP level. GP level prioritization of beneficiaries should be conducted during *GP prioritization and consolidation meeting*. This will be the GP level Entitlement Plan

Process of Livelihood Plan Preparation

SHG Level Demand Preparation:

Livelihood Demands of SHG members/ group of members will be prepared in each SHG on the basis of priority.

1.Farming: Individual & Group Farming

2. Animal Husbandry: Individual & Group

3.Micro Enterprise : Individual ME & Group ME

VO Level Summary Sheet / Consolidation :

The SHG level demands have to be attached along with the VO summary sheet at VO level. Demands of vulnerable/PoP members outside SHG fold should be included at this level. This will be the VO level Livelihood Plan

GP level Prioritization for:

- 1.Farming : Individual & Group Farming
- 2. Animal Husbandry: Individual & Group
- 3. Micro Enterprise : Individual ME & Group ME

GP Level Summary Sheet / Consolidation :

If there are more than one VO in a GP, then the VO level Livelihood plans should be attached along with the GP summary sheet at GP level. GP level prioritization of the demands should be conducted during *GP prioritization and consolidation meeting*. This will be the GP level Livelihood Plan

Process of Public goods, services and resource development mapping

VO Level Mapping:

Mapping of public goods and resource at the VO level. Discuss about the service demands and include it in the format. All the demands should be on the basis of priority

GP Level Summary Sheet / Consolidation:

If there are more than one VO in a GP, then the demands from the mapping by the VOs should be attached along with the GP level summary sheet. GP level prioritization of the demands should be conducted during GP prioritization and consolidation meeting

Process of SDP preparation

VO level discussion:

VO level discussion to identify the social issues and to plan interventions for the same. This will be at the VO EC meeting after *VO concept seeding meeting*.

VO Level Plan Preparation:

Facilitator along with VO representatives along with the support of BMMU officials can convert the social issues and the interventions into a written plan as per the format

GP Level SDP plans/ summary sheet:

If more than one VO comes up with the same social issue, those plans can be combined and converted to a single plan. Attach the GP summary sheet along with it.

GP level Consolidation/ Summary Sheet

- After VO level summary sheets have been prepared for each VO in a GP, a GP level meeting with all the VOs must be organised.
- At least two members per VO must be present in this meeting to ensure representation of all VOs
- The SHG level entitlement plan must be revisited. The column titled 'Rank for Prioritisation' must be filled during this meeting.



Things to Remember

- 1. After VO level summary sheets have been prepared for each VO in a GP, a GP level meeting with all the VOs must be organised.
- 2. At least two members per VO must be present in this meeting to ensure representation of all VOs
- 3. The SHG level entitlement plan must be revisited. The column titled 'Rank for Prioritisation' must be filled during this meeting.
- 4. Ensure that no demands are duplicated anywhere in the list during GP Consolidation
- 5. Always submit the plans in Gram Sabha and get the approval.
- 6. BMMU representatives should facilitate the GP level prioritization and consolidation
