

Entitlement Plan Preparation for VPRP




What is Entitlement Plan?

- 1. It's a participatory demand plan prepared by SHG members
- 2. This includes demands for Centrally and State Sponsored Schemes of eligible SHG members
- 3. The plan aims to disseminate last mile information about Centrally and State Sponsored Schemes
- 4. Entitlement Plan is made at the SHG Level, consolidated at the VO level and then at the GP Level
- Entitlement demand Plan will ensure maximum integration of entitlements demanded from community in GPDP Plans

Preparations for making an Entitlement Plan

- 1. Prepare a schedule with date and timing for all the SHGs during *VO concept seeding meeting* for conducting Entitlement Plan Preparation
- 2. Prior information to the SHG members about the date and time of meeting
- 3. SHG members should be advised before hand to bring valid id cards. Eg: Ration Card, Aadhar Card, Job Card etc..
- 4. Facilitator should have clarity on criteria (State/Central) for each entitlement for which data is being collected.

Schemes covered under Entitlement Plan



Process of Entitlement Plan Preparation

SHG Level Demand Preparation:

Entitlement Demands of SHG members will be prepared on a prioritized basis in each SHG.

VO Level Summary Sheet/ Consolidation : The SHG level demands have to be attached along with the VO summary sheet at VO level. Demands of vulnerable/PoP members outside SHG fold should be added at this level. This will be the VO level Entitlement Plan

GP Level Summary Sheet / Consolidation:

If there are more than one VO in a GP, then the VO level Entitlement plans should be attached along with the GP summary sheet at GP level. GP level prioritization of beneficiaries should be conducted during *GP prioritization and consolidation meeting*. This will be the GP level Entitlement Plan

Basis for Prioritisation

- SHGs should discuss and write the names of beneficiaries in the order of priorit
- Vulnerable or the marginalised section of the community get preference on availing benefits.
 - Person with Disability
 - Elderly
 - Women headed households including single mother, unwed mother, abandoned, widow and separated etc.
 - Victims of witch hunting
 - Particularly Vulnerable Tribal Groups
 - Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe
 - Homeless and destitute
 - Bed ridden/ Paralysed
 - Persons belonging to Transgender communities
 - Bonded labourers, Migrant labourers
 - Persons with terminal or Incurable disease
 - Woman victims of atrocities/trafficking
 - Sanitation workers
 - Households with no source of income

SHG level Entitlement Plan Preparation

- 1. Prepared at SHG level in a SHG meeting
- 2. Name of beneficiaries of each demand at SHG is captured
- 3. Always write the name of the beneficiaries in the order of priority
- 4. Schemes covered are:

- 1. MGNREGS : Job Card , Individual work demand and Community work demand
- 2. NSAP: Old age pension, Widow pension and Disability pension
- 3. SBM
- 4. Health Card
- 5. Ujjwala Scheme
- 6. Ration card
- 7. Saubhagya
- 8. PMSBY
- 9. PMJBY
- 10. PMAY –G
- 5. States can always add any other state specific schemes into the list

Formats

Things to Remember

- 1. Do not call a meeting randomly, fix a date and time for each SHG based on the discussion during *VO concept seeding meeting*.
- 2. Facilitator should remind the SHG leaders about the SHG meeting for plan preparation at least one day before the plan preparation
- 3. Facilitator should inform the SHG that these are demands and its not necessary that all the demands will get fulfilled.
- 4. Collecting of contact numbers of SHG leaders will help in better coordination.
- 5. Always remember, it is a process of participatory planning.
- 6. The name of beneficiaries should be written in prioritised order in SHG format
- 7. Keep the column 'Rank for prioritization' blank while doing SHG level plan preparation.






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Livelihood Plan Preparation for VPRP



What is Livelihood Plan?

- 1. The plan consist of Livelihood demands from SHG members
- 2. To create avenues for new livelihood opportunities and provide the required support
- 3. Plan covers both Individual as well as group demands of SHG members
- 4. Livelihood Plan focuses on three major sectors, which are Farming, Animal Husbandry and Micro Enterprise
- 5. Livelihood Plan is made at the SHG Level, consolidated at the VO level and then at the GP Level

Preparations for making a Livelihood Plan

- Prepare a schedule with date and timing for all the SHGs during VO concept seeding meeting for conducting Livelihood Plan Preparation
- 2. Prior information to the SHG members about the date and time of meeting
- Facilitator should be aware of the various schemes and supports provided for livelihood by different departments and SRLM
- 4. Demands corresponding to livelihoods can be considered under GP/ Local bodies fund as well as through available schemes / services from various departments

Sectors of Livelihood Plan

FARMING

- Comprises of demands for individual and group farming on own & lease land
- 2. The demand plan may also specify support that the SHG member requires
- 3. The demands for farming can be addressed either through local bodies or departments
- 4. Agriculture Department , Horticulture Department, Land, Soil and Water Conservation Department, Irrigation Department, Sericulture Department

ANIMAL HUSBANDRY

- 1. Demands for both individual and group initiatives
- 2. Comprises of demands for livestock rearing like cows, goats, buffalo, poultry, fishery, etc.
- 3. The demand plan may also specify support that the SHG member requires for animal husbandry
- 4. The demands for animal husbandry can be addressed either through local bodies or departments
- 5. Animal husbandry department, Fisheries department

MICRO ENTERPRISES

- 1. Comprises of demands to start micro enterprise units, for both individual and group enterprises.
- 2. The demand plan may also specify support that the SHG member requires
- 3. The demands for micro enterprises can be addressed either through local bodies or departments
- 4. Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises & Food processing Industries

Examples of livelihood demands and the supports

FARMING

- Banana Plantation
- Coconut Plantation
- Rice/wheat Plantation
- Lemon Plantation
- Vegetable Cultivation

Examples of Support:

- Equipment
- Subsidy for equipment
- Irrigation facilities
- Soil Testing
- Crop Insurance
- Seeds/ Saplings
- Training

ANIMAL HUSBANDRY

- Poultry
- Goatry
- Fishery
- Piggery
- Cattles
- Bee keeping

Examples of Support:

- Quality Livestock
- Infrastructure for livestock
- Fodder
- Vaccine / Veterinary Services
- Subsidy for the purchase of livestock
- Animal Insurance

MICRO ENTERPRISES

- Weaving
- Papad-making
- Garment store
- General store
- Bakery
- Beauty parlour
- Catering services
- Sound and Light rental

Examples of Support:

- Designing and packing
- Equipment for food processing, drying, handloom, Handicraft etc
- Storage Units
- Training

Process of Livelihood Plan Preparation

SHG Level Demand Preparation:

Livelihood Demands of SHG members/ group of members will be prepared in each SHG on the basis of priority. 1.Farming : Individual & Group Farming
2.Animal Husbandry : Individual & Group
3.Micro Enterprise : Individual ME & Group ME

VO Level Summary Sheet / Consolidation : The SHG level demands have to be attached along with the VO summary sheet at VO level. Demands of vulnerable/PoP members outside SHG fold should be included at this level. This will be the VO level Livelihood Plan

GP Level Summary Sheet / Consolidation :

If there are more than one VO in a GP, then the VO level Livelihood plans should be attached along with the GP summary sheet at GP level. GP level prioritization of the demands should be conducted during *GP prioritization and consolidation meeting*. This will be the GP level Livelihood Plan

SHG level Livelihood Plan Preparation

- 2. Name of individuals / groups interested in livelihood is captured
- 3. Always write the name of the individuals / groups in the order of priority
- 4. Sectors covered are:

- 1. Farming : Individual and Group
- 2. Animal Husbandry : Individual and Group
- 3. Micro Enterprise : Individual and Group
- 5. Support for each sector of livelihood demands can come either from GP/ local bodies or from different departments

Livelihood Plan preparation in Manipur
